Group's first meeting is a success

The inaugural meeting of the National CT Head Reporting Radiographers Special Interest Group took place at Birmingham City University on 4 June.

The group was developed to provide a forum for CT head reporting radiographers to get together and share their experiences, hopefully providing opportunities to assist and support individuals whilst striving to develop and enhance relevant professional practice.

The meeting was well-attended and interesting introductory discussions occurred, as like-minded people talked around the issues that concerned them in their day-to-day professional endeavours. Topics touched upon included: producing schemes of work, developing a robust audit-chain of competency evidence, and the variety of reporting practices undertaken from centre to centre.

There were also succinct (some would say challenging) case presentations given by several of the group's delegates, as well as a talk on developing a follow-up protocol in cases of spontaneous intracerebral haemorrhage.

The group was privileged to receive an impressive demonstration of new application software for the iPhone that is directed primarily at radiographers, which will allow users access to formidable reference tools to assist them in their professional activities.

It is hoped that this new and exciting SIG will meet once every six months (the next meeting is tentatively planned for November). If you are a CT head reporting radiographer or someone who is interested in this avenue of advanced practice, then you are encouraged to come along and join us.
