

# What to expect in your first 18 months at HEFT Imaging Directorate.

## Approx 8 weeks...

Meet with Training & Development Co-ordinator to discuss CPD and Preceptorship. Allocated with a Band 6 Trained Preceptor. Given a Preceptorship folder which forms the basis of a CPD folder. Booked on to attend a 3 day multidisciplinary Trust Preceptorship course over a 6 month period.

## Start Date...

Attend 2 day Trust Induction University.

## Post Induction ...

Take part in the Out of Hours Service. Perform CT Head and Neck to support the Out of Hours Service.

## During first 12 Months....

Have regular documented meetings with your assigned Preceptor to review and discuss your folder. Once folder has been completed a final meeting with Training & Development Co-ordinator to sign off Preceptorship folder & receive a certificate of completion.

## Day 3...

Meet with Site Lead at Base Site. Given induction documents. Tour of the Department. 12 week clinical induction scheduled.

## During first 3 Months....

Have arranged meetings with Site Lead to review induction documents. Meetings arranged for a 5 and 10 week review. At 12 weeks will be put onto the out of hours rota when all areas are signed off.

## Approx 8 weeks...

Booked on to attend a 3 day multidisciplinary Trust Preceptorship course over a 6 month period.  
**Day 1:** Professionalism, Documentation, Communication  
**Day 2:** Team Working, Assertiveness, Clinical Governance, Problem Solving  
**Day 3:** Patient Experience, Attitudes & Grief, Research, Dementia Care.

## Post Preceptorship ...

Organise to attend the Birmingham City University Student Mentor & Assessor Training. Become a Student Mentor & Assessor. Use CPD time to gain experience in areas of interest, e.g. ultrasound, MRI, NM, Interventional, Cardiology, Paediatrics
